
Who are we


IFCF is a community-driven initiative powered by passionate Kannadigas who are deeply connected to Karnataka and its rich traditions.


Our team is a diverse collective of volunteers, cultural enthusiasts, and food lovers committed to preserving and promoting Karnataka's cultural heritage.



 - marquees (stall) 3m x 3m size
 - 2 trestle tables
 - 2 chairs
- IFCF will charge \$350 for each marquee
- All temporary or mobile food and beverage premises operating within the state of Victoria are required to be registered under the Food Act and lodge a Statement of Trade for each selected event through the online registration database Food Trader.
- A Statement of Trade is required to be submitted by 26th October 2024.
